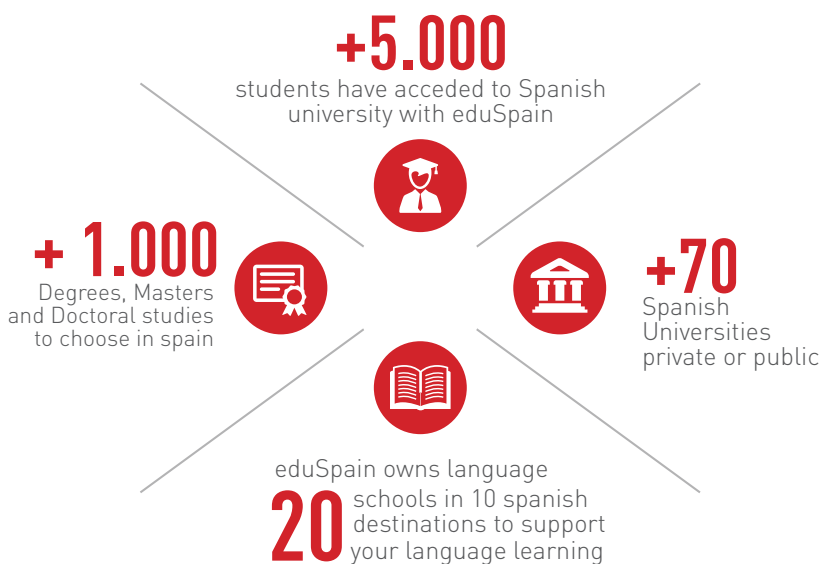

PREPARATION COURSE FOR PAU (Preparation for Spanish University entry exams)

This course is specifically tailored to students hoping to be admitted to Spanish universities (both public and private). This Enforex course helps students improve their Spanish in order to be able to effectively study for the exam. The Prueba de Acceso a la Universidad (PAU) is the standard university admissions exam required by the Spanish Ministry of Education. Our courses are designed to help prospective students acquire the knowledge necessary to pass the exam, as well as to assist them in the application process for the institution of their choice. Available in two formats of five and eight months respectively.

eduSpain UNIVERSITY PATHWAY 24 – 36 months

The eduSpain Pathway Program for International Students is a 24 – 36 month program, designed for international students who wish to complete an undergraduate degree, master or doctoral study in any Spanish University. In this program, international students fast-track their education by combining language and credit studies. WStudents complete first-year university completing Spanish courses to meet the language requirements for university



UNDERGRADUATE: DEGREE

Undergraduate studies are the first level of teaching in the new University order, which is reached with a Baccalaureate or equivalent qualification, and by passing the University entrance exam (PAU). Graduate qualifications are divided into the following categories: Arts and Humanities, Sciences, Health Sciences, Social legal and Educational Sciences and Engineering and Architecture.



MASTERS STUDIES

Upon completion of the undergraduate degree program, successful graduates have two options: to join the workforce or continue their studies for a Masters degree which complements their previous studies with further specialization. The Masters degree program has a duration of 1 to 2 years (60 or 120 ECTS) involving either professional training or academic research. At the end of the Masters program an oral public presentation of a thesis or research project is required and counts for a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 30 credits.



DOCTORAL STUDIES

The objective of Doctoral studies is to further master the skills and method of research in the student's chosen field of study. The two components of study for the Doctorate degree comprise of courses and the writing and defense of a doctoral dissertation. A research-oriented Master's degree (or its equivalent issued by a European Higher Education Space university) is required to gain entry into the Doctoral program. Degree-holding students with a minimum of the 60 credits required in one or more Masters programs may gain access to the Doctoral program, as well as those students in possession of a research-orientated Undergraduate degree with at least 300 credits.

MADRID



UNIVERSIDAD DE ALCALÁ

The Universidad de Alcalá, founded in 1499, enrolls 25,000 students a year. Located in the historic town of Alcalá near Madrid and is one of the oldest universities in Spain. Its dedication to the heritage of Spanish language and culture is demonstrated by its being the site of the annual Cervantes Prize and its promotion of the exchange of students between Spain and the Americas in many areas. One example is its collaboration with the Banco Santander promoting studies in Finance through its ClIFF Foundation.



MADRID



UNIVERSIDAD ANTONIO DE NEBRIJA

Private university, founded in 1995, enrolls 3,000 Spanish and International students a year, fully accredited by the Spanish government. Located in Madrid with emphasis on academic quality and development of professional skills. One of the top universities in the world in teaching Spanish as a second language. International atmosphere and personal attention, with student/teacher ratio of 10 to 1.

BARCELONA



UNIVERSIDAD AUTÓNOMA DE BARCELONA

The Universidad Autònoma de Barcelona, founded in 1968, enrolls 45,000 students a year at its three campuses: Sant Pau in Barcelona and Bellaterra and Sabadell on the outskirts of the city. It offers 77 undergraduate and masters degree programs, 90 doctoral and 380 postgraduate programs in many fields in the humanities, social sciences, medicine, experimental sciences and engineering.

UNIVERSIDAD DE BARCELONA

The Universidad de Barcelona, founded in 1450, recently celebrated its 555th anniversary. It is one of the most important research universities in Europe both for its number of research programs and their quality. With 20 buildings and two University Schools in four campuses, it is the second largest Spanish university with over 74,000 students. Estudios Hispánicos is the institution within UB responsible for the training of foreign students in Spanish language and culture with over 60 years of uninterrupted tradition in the teaching of Spanish.



TOLEDO



UNIVERSIDAD DE CASTILLA-LA MANCHA

The Universidad de Castilla – La Mancha, founded in 1985, enrolls 35,000 students a year at four campuses (Albacete, Ciudad Real, Cuenca, and Toledo). It has 14 buildings and 22 University Schools. It is a young, dynamic university with a wide variety of academic offerings. Many of its classes are held in historic buildings, in locations of great cultural interest to international students.



BILBAO



UNIVERSIDAD DE DEUSTO

The Universidad de Deusto, founded by the Jesuits in 1886, is located in the heart of Bilbao, in front of the world-famous Guggenheim Museum. It enrolls 14,000 students and gives particular attention to their professional and personal growth. It has nine buildings, four University Schools and eleven institutes.

It is responsible for composing and correcting the Spanish language exams, DELE (Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera) which are the only ones officially recognized by the Spanish government.

Before arriving in Spain you must obtain the student residence visa (visado de estancia por estudios) from the Spanish consulate in your country of origin or legal residence. You can find your consulate on the website of the Spanish Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

To apply for a visa, you need an accreditation of acceptance on a eduSpain study programme, among other documents. You can request this accreditation from:

"EMPADRONAMIENTO": support or personal assistance (Registration of residency)

All those who plan to spend longer than 90 days in Spain will need to apply for residency status (residencia).

Registering on the padrón is not only an official requirement, it also brings a number of benefits such as access to some aspects of social care (after a certain period of time), potential reductions in a number of charges and taxes, discounts on courses/activities organised by the Town Hall and also voting rights in local and European elections. The padrón certificate is also required for other things such as healthcare, education and obtaining Spanish number plates for your car.

Frequently asked questions

What do I need to be able to study in Spain?

- A passport, which complies with official regulations.
- Signed and valid for at least six months.
- A visa. You can apply for a student visa at your nearest Spanish Embassy or Consulate in your country.
- If you want to take an official, certified program at a Spanish university, you must have legitimate documentation of your academic qualifications so that they can be recognized in Spain. These documents are not required for Spanish language and culture courses or for any non-official program which is not State approved.

Do I need a high level of Spanish to study at a Spanish university?

Yes, in most universities you will have to take a test to confirm your linguistic ability. Universities may also consider the student's résumé to verify this ability.

What other requirements are needed to study at a Spanish university?

If you have not studied at a University in your own country: You must submit the relevant documentation to the Ministry of Education in Spain to confirm your secondary education. All the documents that you bring must be official and issued by able authorities, in accordance with the legal regulations of your country. If you are from a country which has signed the "Hague Convention", a document which has been certified with a conformant "apostille" will be accepted for legal use. If you are from a Member State of the European Union or a country which has signed the "European Economic Area Agreement", you will not be required to provide any form of legalization. For every other country, documents must be legalized through diplomatic channels. The confirmation of these entrance requirements is carried out by the "Universidad Nacional de Educación a Distancia", (UNED).

Furthermore, if you are coming from a country whose education system does not belong to one of the member States of the European Union or does not have bilateral agreements with Spain in terms of education; you will have to pass a series of aptitude tests to be able to study at a University in Spain. These are called "Pruebas de Aptitud para el Acceso a la Universidad (PAU)" in Spain. There are specific entrance exams for foreign students, organized by the UNED. If you have already studied at a University in your own country and you wish to continue your studies in Spain, you must apply for a partial validation for the part of your degree you have taken so far.

How long does the process of authorizing and validating my studies in Spain take?

Approximately three months from the time you apply to the final decision.

What requirements do I need to be able to do a Masters in a Spanish university?

You must have a university degree and in some cases, you will need to authorize it with the equivalent Spanish degree through the "Ministry of Science and Innovation".

How long does it take to study for a Degree and for a Masters in Spain?

It takes 4 or 5 years to study for a Degree and from 7 months to 2 years to study for a Masters.

If I fulfill the entrance requirements for a Spanish university, can I enroll in any degree course through eduSpain?

Not in all cases. There are certain universities which, because of their exceptional merits, require self improvement and personal development of the same. Furthermore, each university has limited quotas for admissions of foreign students. However, Eduspain is in charge of coordinating everything to make this procedure easier.

Con cuánto tiempo de antelación tengo que solicitar entrar en una universidad española?

Para estudios de Grado es conveniente comenzar el proceso de solicitud a eduSpain un año antes del curso académico en el que desee ingresar. En el caso de Máster es suficiente con hacerlo 5 ó 6 meses antes de comenzar.

¿How much does it cost to do a Degree or a Masters in Spain?

- A Degree at a public university costs, on average, 1,000 euros per academic year.
- A Degree at a private university costs, on average, 6,300 euros per academic year.
- A Masters costs from 4,000 to 30,000 euros, depending on where you study, for how long you study etc.

Is it possible to get a grant for my studies?

Although it is not impossible, a grant is very difficult to get. eduSpain can give you some information about the opportunities it can give before you decide to start the application process.
